WHY IS THIS REFERENDUM SO IMPORTANT FOR THE FUTURE OF SOUTH ORANGE?

South Orange voters have the opportunity to secure \$69.7 million to benefit the community for decades to come through the sale of the water system to New Jersey American Water, the same company that has been contracted to manage the water system and provide water to the Village.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF **VOTING YES** ON THE WATER SYSTEM REFERENDUM?

RATE PREDICTABILITY

Customers will experience rate predictability under New Jersey American Water.

- Five-year rate schedule upon taking ownership, with a rate hold for the first two years and 3% annual increases in years 3-5
- Rates regulated by the NJBPU

CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

H2O Help to Others Program™:

 Includes grants up to \$500 toward overdue water bills, and service charge discounts to customers with qualifying incomes

INVESTING IN SOUTH ORANGE

New Jersey American Water is committed to investing \$69.7 million in South Orange if voters approve the sale:

- \$19.7 million purchase price to pay off all the water utility debt, with the remainder applied to municipal debt
- \$50 million in infrastructure investments by 2035 that
 - o Identification and replacement of all lead and galvanized service lines starting immediately after taking ownership
 - o Replacement of the Crest Drive Standpipe within five years of ownership to address NJDEP requirements and secure this important water storage facility
 - o Rehabilitation of the Main Reservoir and the Newstead Watersphere to strengthen the system's resiliency and address deficiencies identified by the state regulators and the Village
 - o An aggressive water main replacement and rehabilitation program
 - o A comprehensive analysis of the system to prioritize other system improvements

LONG-TERM RATE PREDICTABILITY IN SOUTH ORANGE

Upon sale of the system, current water rates will be held steady for two years, followed by minimal increases of 3% per year over the next three years, while critical system improvements are made. In the long-term, customers' rates will increase modestly every two to three years due to New Jersey American Water's ability to spread costs across its entire customer base. If the Village was to keep and maintain the system, rates will immediately increase significantly.

At the end of the five years, customers with average water usage will pay approximately \$78 more annually for water service while New Jersey American Water invests tens of millions of dollars in South Orange.
